How can I access items & services while the library is closed for the move?

Hopkinton items will not be accessible for holds, browsing, borrowing or returns. **You can borrow items from any other CW/MARS library** in person OR you can put holds (through your online account) on items from other libraries and select a convenient pick up location of your choice, such as Milford or Southborough. (Ashland & Holliston are not in our library network.) **You cannot select "Hopkinton" as a pickup location.**

To request items through the CW/MARS Network, select the 'Manage your Account' option from the upper right corner of the library website. Log in with your library card number and your pin number.

You will need to return borrowed items to any library in the CW/MARS system besides Hopkinton.

Online resources, e-book to download, e-audio books or periodicals, and videos are available from our website.

Services not available during the moving period:

Museum passes, story hours, programs, and computers.

What will happen to Hopkinton items that are due during the moving period?

Due dates for Hopkinton materials will be extended to our re-opening date. No late fees will occur during this moving period. **Items belonging to other libraries will not have extended due dates. These must be returned on time to other local CW/MARS libraries.**
