PART 3: Selecting a Program for a reader

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Add Readers

Choose a Program

Youth: Pre-Readers
Recommended for kids who have not yet started Kindergarten (approximately 0-5 years old). Children can complete this program with an adult - listening to a reader counts!
Children will complete the program when they have earned 600 points! Points are earned by recording the minutes read (with an adult) or by completing different activities. Kids will earn a badge every 50 points!

Youth: Marathon-Elmwood Readers
Recommended for kids **rising up** to 1st, 2nd, or 3rd grade in September 2020!
Children will complete the program when they have earned 900 points! Points are earned by recording the minutes read or by completing different activities. Kids will earn a badge every 75 points!

Youth: Hopkins Readers
Recommended for kids **rising up** to 4th or 5th grade in September 2020!
Children will complete the program when they have earned 1200 points! Points are earned by recording the minutes read or by completing different activities. Kids will earn a badge every 100 points!

Teen Pizza Party
Earn 1200 points, through various reading and participating activities, to enter into a drawing to win gift cards to local pizza parlors! Drawings will be held twice this summer, at the end of July and August, so you have two opportunities to win! Earn a badge for every 100 points you complete, and try to win all 12 Days of Summer badges!

Teen Coffee and Muffins
Earn 1200 points, through reading and participation in activities, to enter a drawing to win gift cards for local coffee and muffin eateries! Drawings will occur twice over the summer, at the end of July and August, so you have two chances to win! Earn a badge for every 100 points you complete, and try to win all 12 Days of Summer badges!

Teen Ice Cream Social
Earn 1200 points through reading and participation in various activities to enter a drawing to win gift cards to local ice cream establishments! Drawings will occur twice over the summer, at the end of July and August, so you have two chances to win! Earn a badge for every 100 points you complete, and try to win all 12 Days of Summer badges!
